# UNIVERSE AWARENESS (UNAWE) Astronomy-based program with social goals




## Exposes DISADVANTAGED young children (4 – 10) to INSPIRATIONAL aspects of astronomy

- Use **PERSPECTIVE** of astronomy to
  - Broaden children's minds
    - Stimulate sense of internationalism, tolerance, respect at age when value-systems are formed
- Use INSPIRATION and FUN of astronomy to
  - Introduce excitement of science
    - Demonstrate power of rational thought
    - Motivate development of language and numeric skills


Rates of Return for Human Capital Investment at Different Ages

- August 2003 Research Plan NL Academy Professorship
  - Small part to initiating a scheme for exposing young children in the underdeveloped world to inspirational aspects of modern astronomy.
- October 2003 Meeting at **ESO** with Richard West and Claus Madsen Strong support
- 25 February 2004
  - Letter seeking funds to Cornelis van Bochove, DG Science Policy, NL Ministry
     Education Culture & Research
- 27 October 2004 Meeting at European Schoolnet Brussels
  - ESO: Claus Madsen, U Leiden: George Miley, EUN: Alexa Joyce, Thomas Maier, Santi Scimeca, EAAE: Fernand Wagner

- 27 28 May 2005: First UNAWE Workshop, ESO Garching

  - Pilot projects in Chile, Indonesia, Tunisia, South Africa
  - Reach 200,000 children in 8 countries starting in 2009

- Advert for PM -June 2005
  - 1 September 2005 Carolina Ödman appointed part-time PM
- October 2005 UNESCO GA Paris Lobbying

#### PRE-HISTORY OF UNIVERSE AWARENESS -3

- September 2006 Ministry of Education Culture and Science 3 year startup
  - Received personally from Dutch Minister of Education Culture and Science,
     Maria van der Hoeven
- Global cornerstone of UN-ratified International Year of Astronomy IYA2009
- Official programme of International Astronomical Union, embedded in decadal IAU Strategic Plan "Astronomy for Development"
- BOTTOM-UP network of > 500 dedicated multidisciplinary experts in > 60 countries






## **EU**- UNIVERSE AWARENESS (**EUNAWE**)



Astronomy-based program with educational and social goals

- 2011 -2013: Implementation in 5 EU member states and South Africa
  - Allocated 2.5M Euro
  - Germany, Italy, Netherlands, Spain, UK (N. Ireland)
  - South Africa
    - National coordinators+materials+teacher training+exchanges



#### SUPPORT IN EU PARLIAMENT

- PARLIAMENTARY AMENDMENT 898 TO 2009 BUDGET(Teresa Riera Madurell MEP)
  - Actions will include activities in the framework of the International Year of Astronomy (IYA2009) +2MEuro in 2010 budget
    - IYA2009 emphasizes outreach to young people.
- Written Declaration 45/2011 of European Parliament 15 March 2012 (signed by 394 MEPs)
  - RECOGNISING THAT further European involvement in African radio astronomy can become a powerful driver of socioeconomic growth in Africa
  - SUPPORTS the development of science capacity in Africa through greater investment in research infrastructures, with particular focus on radio astronomy
- Parliamentary Questions about continuation of UNAWE March 2012 (Alyn Smith MEP)
- 2013 Support from 11 MEPs, 7 countries, 5 parliamentary groups

#### **UNAWE 2025 – PERSONAL THOUGHTS ON FUTURE - 1**

- UNAWE/ Pale Blue Dot –type programme more than ever needed, given geopolitical trends
  - Nationalism, populism, ethnicism, nuclear war, climate change threaten survival of species and planet
- To be effective > implementation on GLOBAL SCALE adapted to local cultures
  - Large funding sources needed unsuitable for normal proposal call
  - Partnership between research astronomers and teachers essential
  - Think about possible partnership with other relevant sciences, arts + culture??
  - New generation of proponents need to be recruited
    - Dedicated driven idealist + diplomats + pragmatists

#### **UNAWE 2025 – PERSONAL THOUGHTS ON FUTURE -2**

#### POSSIBLE ROADMAP

- Mobilise influential senior researcher astronomers
  - Uniqueness of UNAWE/PBT approach
- Approach distinguished potential patrons via senior international research astronomers
  - e.g. Calibre of ex- Minister Pandor and Prof. Mokhele from SA
- Recruit idealist volunteers from young researchers and teachers throughout world
- Draw up multi-year plan with appropriate partners (e.g. OAD, OAE ++) and discuss with national Academies
- Exploit network to approach sympathetic politicians, administrators, foundations and international organisations
- Min. initial funding (~2 FTE) for highly-motivated charismatic PM to lay ground
